



Weekly Tip November 27, 2023 8 Tips for Effective Written Requests

Hey Rick,

Want to make your written requests as strong as possible? Then strongly consider applying these quidelines.

- 1.- Use pronouns that involve them, "you" and "we" are superior to "I".
- 2.- Appeal on the basis of benefit (for them, your ministry audience), not needs.
- 3.- Ask (appel for) partners, not money.
- 4.- Create more than just a letter, create an experience.
- 5.- Write clearly, concisely, and use a persuasive tone.
- 6.- USE stories. Use emotion. Remember, "numbers only tell a fraction of the story."
- 7.- Use urgency legitimately. It is almost always present, but don't ever fake it.
- 8.- Write the length of the letter you need to express your case well. Don't write a book, but don't shortchange yourself either.
